NOTICE TO CONTRIBUTORS

Oryx accepts papers and notes dealing with wild life, especially with wild life conservation.

Contributors are asked to observe the following points:—

MSS. should be typed, preferably with double spacing, or clearly written.

Capitals should be used for proper names but not for English names of animals or plants.

Numbers should be spelt out unless they occur very frequently, when they may be given in figures.

The scientific name (underlined in MSS. to indicate italics) follows the English name in brackets without any intervening stop.

The writer's signature, in the form in which it is to appear when printed, should be given in BLOCK CAPITALS.

Articles may be abbreviated by the Editor.

Maps or graphs must be neatly and boldly drawn in Indian ink on good quality white paper or Bristol board, with due allowance for reduction.

The author of an article will, on request made at the time of submission, be sent free up to 25 copies of Oryx or 25 reprints of the article.
