First World Congress

Date: 8 - 12 October 1996

The Congress is being organized by The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, the World Health Organization, and the Italian National Federation for Osteoporosis Centers, in collaboration with the National Research Council and the National Institute of Nutrition.
