

“The Rockefeller Archive Center has published a revised and enlarged guide to the Center’s holdings which include the papers of John D. Rockefeller, The Rockefeller University, The Rockefeller Foundation, the Rockefeller Brothers Fund, the General Education Board, the Laura Spelman Rockefeller Memorial, other organizations founded by the Rockefellers, and individuals associated with the Rockefeller philanthropies. Copies are available from the Center, Pocantico Hills, North Tarrytown, NY 10591.”

“The Rockefeller Archive Center of Rockefeller University awards grants of not more than \$1,500 to scholars, usually graduate students or post-doctoral scholars, who are engaged in projects which require use of the holdings at the Center. The size of individual grants will be dependent upon the travel, temporary lodging, and research expenses of the applicant. Applications for the 1983 grant year should be received by December 31, 1982. The names of the recipients will be announced in March of the grant year.
