Usually once a year a cassette of music examples accompanies the Journal and contributors may wish to take advantage of this. Photographs and other illustrations are welcomed.

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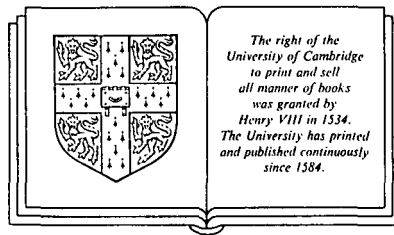
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NOTES FOR CONTRIBUTORS
