
With a Foreword by Reginald Murley, President of the Royal College of Surgeons of England

This book is the first of its kind to be written and covers the history of medical and surgical instruments from the Middle Ages to 1870; with it are chapters on dental and veterinary pieces and such adjuncts of the sickroom as feeding utensils, medicine receptacles, and those items of the toilet concerned with hygiene, as well as early spectacles and ear trumpets. Through the instruments one may find a mass of social comment and a dramatic account of medical history, culminating in Lister's victory over septicaemia which separates the instruments in this book from those of today. With the introduction of antisepsis and the eventual acceptance of sterilization for all instruments, they necessarily became plainer and less interesting, and the more decorative materials were precluded from use.

For the growing number of collectors this book is long overdue and for them the Directory of Surgical Instrument Makers will be invaluable providing, as it does, a framework for the dating of pieces by named makers. Included for the layman is a simple glossary of terminology and a chart showing, internationally, the comparative dates of doctors and surgeons. The book is profusely illustrated with 382 photographs originating from many different sources.

Elisabeth Bennion has, for the last six years, worked for Simon Kaye Ltd., Silversmiths, where instruments made in silver first excited her enthusiasm for wider study.
