

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Scripts. Papers, written in English, should be typed in double spacing on one side of the paper with a margin of at least 4 cm on the left-hand side. Two copies should be submitted.

Layout and style. Authors are recommended to use the style adopted in recent issues. Details and sample pages showing preferred layout for various subjects may be obtained in advance of submission from the Executive Editor, Miss Jane King, at the address given above.

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Figures should be restricted to the display of results when a large number of values can be comprehended more easily; Tables and Figures may not reproduce the same data. Line drawings should be 25 cm wide and drawn in black waterproof ink on Bristol Board, graph paper with blue lines or tracing paper. Numbering and lettering, which must be kept to an absolute minimum, should be legibly inserted in soft pencil. A photocopy of the line drawing should be provided; a full legend describing the Figure and giving a key to all the symbols on it should be typed on a separate sheet.

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
