Ray Albright contributed notably to the world of Church History by nearly forty years of teaching, first at Reading and later at Cambridge, and by his successive publications. His latest works, a life of Phillips Brooks, *Focus in Infinity*, and a *History of the Protestant Episcopal Church* show him at the height of his powers and reflect the qualities which all who knew him well will remember—the integrity of the scholar, the ecumenical spirit of the churchman, and the natural simplicity and cheerful friendliness of the Christian man.

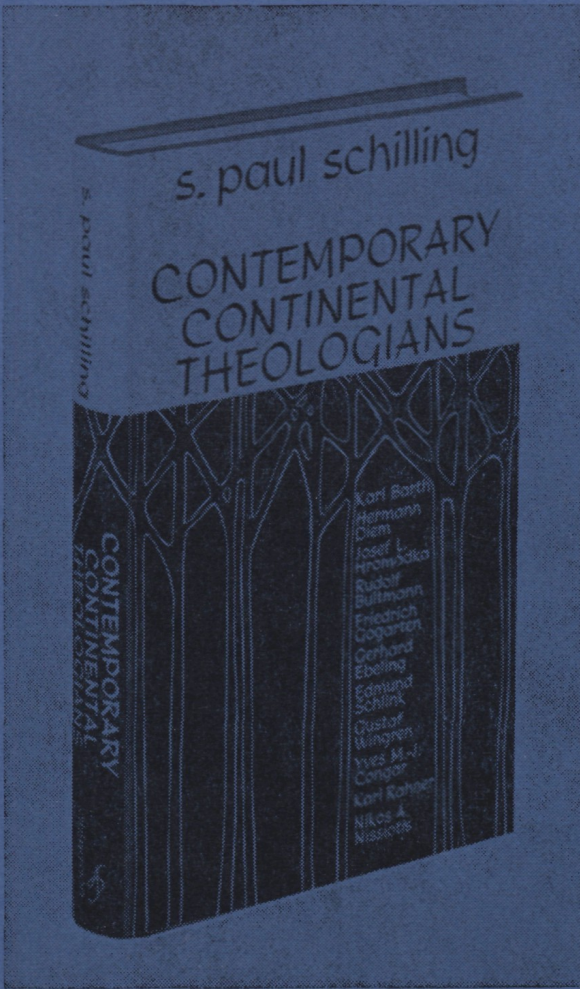
