

This volume of more than 300 pages contains sermons for every Sunday in the year. They are not homilies, not step-by-step commentaries on the texts of the Epistles and Gospels. Rather the subjects are suggested by the Mass of each Sunday. Thus, for example, for Easter the topic is "Peter's Pence": for the Seventeenth Sunday after Pentecost, "Fortune by the Wayside": for the Twentieth Sunday, "The Blessings of Sickness".

The apt anecdotes abounding throughout the volume are uncommon and are taken from a wide variety of sources: Scripture, history, biography, and even mythology. These stories are so closely related to the doctrine or moral which they illustrate that the lesson will be remembered whenever the story is recalled.

The principles of Christian living are nineteen hundred years old. In God and the Soul they are presented with a welcome freshness.


