Responses, passionate and informative, on China. Earlier this year *Worldview* published a series of three articles on *The Other China*, written by Ivan and Miriam London. *The Other China*, based on years of monitoring news from China and from intensive interviews with refugees, presented a view of that vast country that was unfamiliar to most readers in the United States and elsewhere. It called into question, for example, the belief that China, in spite of undeniably great efforts, has overcome the problems of producing and distributing food equitably to its populace, the belief that beggars no longer exist, and that prostitution has been overcome.

This series has elicited a significant response from China scholars and observers in a number of countries. Debate, discussion, and sharp argumentation have been initiated by *The Other China* and will, it seems evident, continue.
