
would a any senior consultant. However, 'minor' errors in judgement are slightly sneered at and you are allowed to continue, although a 'final report' is made of your skills. Despite being in good humour, they are accurate scenarios backed up with a sound knowledge base. It must be remembered that this site is dedicated to trauma, where things are prioritised differently than the anaesthetic or recovery room, and any guesswork or assumption is quickly ruled out. The website also contains a small library of pictures of

injuries following trauma, this is well set out and easy to navigate. The website also contains a trauma bank, which allows clinicians to discuss current cases and learn from the experiences of others. This is very useful as there is no recriminations but a genuine desire on the part



of others around the globe to help. With other features including links to trauma organisations both medical and nursing, plus other resources, this is a comprehensive site dedicated to the science of trauma and is well worth a visit for those with an interest.
