CALL FOR PAPERS

Trent University will host an international congress on the philosophy of Rousseau from June 22 — June 25, 1978. The congress will be bilingual, in French and English, and distinguished scholars will be invited from the continent of Europe and from Britain and North America. Invited speakers will treat the theme of the concept of development in Rousseau's philosophy.
