Neuropharmacology relating to schizophrenia has progressed rapidly in recent years. For the first time since the development of neuroleptics in the 1950s, an antipsychotic with improved efficacy is available, and ongoing research promises to yield a range of new products with fewer side-effects and additional activity.
