

THE EXPENDABLE MARY SLESSOR

JAMES BUCHAN



Mary Slessor, from the slums of Dundee, became, in the words of an eminent historian, 'one of the greatest women of her generation'. She worked in Calabar from 1876 until her death in 1915. Its lethal fevers and the Slave Trade had made the place a hell. Close on a million slaves had been shipped from its anchorage and thousands of sick ones butchered in it. The cruelty of the Trade spread through the tribes, destroying their culture and perverting their religion. They lived under a rule of terror.

In 1888, three years before the British moved in, Mary Slessor went into the forests to tackle single-handed the problems of the warring tribes. For the next twenty-eight years she lived among them in mud huts, always going barefoot, sometimes into places where no other white could go without a military escort. Often near death herself, from fever, malnutrition and violence, she saved hundreds of lives, and was the first to make it possible for women to live in independence in Calabar. The story of her courage and endurance might be unbelievable were it not so well attested.
