
***Doctoral Dissertations
on Russia, the Soviet Union, and Eastern
Europe Accepted by American,
Canadian, and British Universities, 1972–1973***

Each year the output of doctoral dissertations on Russia and the Soviet Union accepted by American and Canadian universities is larger than the previous year's, and this year is no exception. This current listing of two hundred seventy-six titles is longer by eighteen than last year's, with twenty-one additional ones for 1971, an additional hundred forty-five for 1972, and one hundred ten for 1973. Steady readers of this introduction know that because degrees are also granted by most universities past the usual June or spring commencement, with some awarded as late as December, complete coverage in current listings is not possible at this time. In addition, the delayed responses of a handful of graduate schools, the practice of a few universities of refusing to compile doctoral lists, the very late appearance of *American Doctoral Dissertations* by as much as two years, and a publication deadline prevent the 1973 listing from being complete.

Of the seventy-seven universities represented (seventy-one American and six Canadian), Columbia University is the outstanding producer by far again, with New York University, the University of California at Berkeley, Harvard University, the University of Washington, the University of California at Los Angeles, and Indiana University also producing a fairly sizable number each, in that order. The listing for Eastern Europe contains one hundred two dissertations from forty-nine American and two Canadian universities. The separate British list is much longer this year because of the compiler's presence in Great Britain this summer, which enabled him to include most of the 1973 items as well as those for 1972. Nine British universities are represented with forty-one titles.

Thirty-seven supplementary items, "auxiliary theses," have been appended to several sections. These dissertations are not concerned primarily with Russia, the Soviet Union, or Eastern Europe, but they do contain enough relevant information to warrant their inclusion. In the listing as a whole, the bulk of the research is again to be found in history, political science, economics, literature, and language.

For earlier lists of dissertations see the author's *Doctoral Research on Russia and the Soviet Union* (New York, 1960), for dissertations accepted through 1959, and the listings that have been published annually in the December issue of the *Slavic Review* since 1964 (the 1964 listing also includes dissertations accepted in 1960–63).
