## DR. GEORGE WEBBER PRIZE

The Friends of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem in Great Britain have established a prize in honour of Dr. George Webber of the University of London.

The sum of IL.500 will be awarded annually for the best contribution accepted for publication in the ISRAEL LAW REVIEW or *MISHPATIM* (Students Law Review) from any student of the Hebrew University working towards the degree of LL.B. or LL.M.

The award will be made by the Dean acting on the recommendation of an advisory committee comprising members of the Editorial Boards of the ISRAEL LAW REVIEW and of *MISHPATIM*. The members of the advisory committee for 1970 were Prof. U. Yadin, Prof. S. Z. Feller and Mr. J. Ben-David.

The prize for 1970 has been awarded to Mr. Mordechai Kremnitzer for his two papers entitled "The Watchman in Israel Neither Slumbers Nor Sleeps" (published in *MISHPATIM*, Vol. 1, No. 2) and "The 10th Amendment of the Road Transport Ordinance. A Further Note" (published in *MISHPATIM*, Vol. 1, No. 3).
