

The Royal College of Psychiatrists has been publishing reading lists of papers since 1970, as a service to trainees, but not as a suggested syllabus for any particular course of training or examination. Since 1977 the Sections have been invited to submit specialized lists, prepared by small working parties. Discussion, editing and preparation in this format have been the responsibility of a Library and Reading Lists Sub-Committee of the Education Committee, with representation from all Sections and with trainee membership, the officers being the Chairman, Dr. John Bowlby (who resigned in 1980 after years of the closest attention to the project) and the Secretary, Dr. Andrew C. Smith.
