REPORT OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON
WEDNESDAY, 25TH APRIL, 1962, AT 5.30 P.M.

The Marquess of Willingdon, President, in the Chair.

1. *The Minutes* of the last Annual General Meeting were read, confirmed, and signed by the Chairman.

2. *Auditor's Report*.—The Chairman proposed and it was carried unanimously that the Report of the Auditors and the Accounts for the year ending 31st December, 1961, be approved and adopted.

3. *Annual Report*.—The Chairman proposed and it was carried unanimously that the Report of the Council for the year ending 31st December, 1961, be approved and adopted.

4. *Election of Officers*.—It was proposed by Mr. E. P. Field, seconded by Dr. E. Hindle and carried unanimously that the Marquess of Willingdon be re-elected President of the Society and Mr. I. D. Malcolmson re-elected Honorary Treasurer.
