From the Introduction

St Paul wrote to some of his converts, 'This is the will of God, your sanctification', which was, after all, only a paraphrase of something Christ Himself had already taught when He gave to all men that precept of perfection, 'Be ye perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect'. This teaching does not contain a mere invitation issued to a small and select body of His followers, but a command addressed to us all, no matter how humble our individual circumstances may be.
