## PMI Initiative Update

At present, the Project to Monitor Indicators (PMI) initiative is responding to an AHRQ priority area looking at medication errors in hospitals. PMI proposes a trial to "Reduce Antimicrobial Prophylaxis Errors" (TRAPE) in 32 to 50 hospitals. The

proposal was prepared by Steve Solomon, MD, Bryan Simmons, MD, Peter Gross, MD, John Burke, MD, Steve Kritchevsky, PhD, and Barbara Braun, who presently seek SHEA's official support of the project.
