SUBMITTING PAPERS

Papers should be sent to Dr Roy H. Smith, *British Journal of Nutrition*, National Institute for Research in Dairying, Shinfield, Reading RG2 9AT, Berkshire. They should be written concisely and must represent the results of original nutritional research (or exceptionally a new interpretation of existing knowledge) not previously published. Full requirements and details of how papers should be prepared are given in Directions to Contributors printed in Part 1 of each volume but authors should also consult a recent issue to acquaint themselves with the style and conventions of the *Journal*. Submitted papers (preferably three copies) should be accompanied by a signed statement to the effect that the author accepts the conditions laid down in Directions to Contributors.
