APSA is pleased to announce that the 2016 MENA Workshops program, entitled “Civil Society Revisited: Research Associational Life in Comparative Perspective,” will be hosted by the American University of Beirut (AUB) and the American University in Cairo (AUC). This two-part workshop program is a unique opportunity to network with colleagues from across the MENA region and develop current research related to civil society in the Arab region and the changing state-society dynamics engendered by the Arab Uprisings of 2011. With support from the Carnegie Corporation of New York, the organizers will cover all costs of participation (including travel, lodging, meals, and materials) for up to 22 qualified applicants. 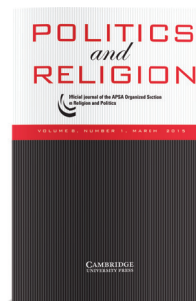

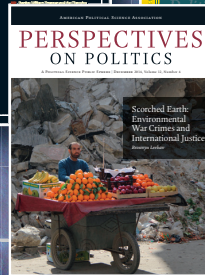
