ETIC and CILT, which occupy adjacent accommodation, maintain jointly the Language-Teaching Library (about 20,000 volumes), where files of journals covered by *Language-Teaching Abstracts* may be consulted. The library also includes an audio-visual section with facilities for hearing and viewing teaching materials; a register of relevant current research is available for reference.

In addition to joint publications such as *Language-Teaching Abstracts*, each centre issues publications from time to time in its own name.
