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The COLLECTED WRITINGS OF MAO TSE-TUNG has the following special features:

1. This is a collection of all the available works of Mao Tse-tung written between 1917 and 1949.
2. The works are printed in the original Chinese.
3. The editors' policy is to print every work by Mao, whether written by himself or jointly with others.
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5. As for those works already included in "Selected Works of Mao Tse-tung" and "Selected Readings from Mao Tse-tung's Works," if an original work is obtained presenting a different form from the already-published one, it is printed with notes detailing the differences between the two.
6. The editors' aim is to present a better and more accurate image of Mao Tse-tung, though the above-mentioned two-point policy may result in some mistakes being made, despite the extreme caution being exercised, because of mistaken attributions and lack of materials.
