The Editor of New Testament Studies, Professor M. Black, reported that the joint editorship with Professor R. McL. Wilson had now run for one year. In 1968-9, 1,686 copies of New Testament Studies had been sold to non-members, 407 to members (total 2,093). A 15-year index of New Testament Studies was under consideration by the C.U.P. In the Monograph Series nine titles had so far appeared, including three in 1968. There were two manuscripts in the press, one was being prepared for the press, and several others were under consideration. An unpublished but completed manuscript of the late Dr Vincent Taylor would be given priority in the publication programme. Other manuscripts were promised. The publication of the texts from Nag Hammadi could not be undertaken by C.U.P., and so would not be included in the Monograph Series. These would be published under other auspices by Brill of Leyden. There would be no changes in the Editorial Board this year.

In 1970 the Society will meet from 24 to 28 August at the University, Newcastleon-Tyne, England; in 1971 from 23 to 27 August at the Free University, Amsterdam; and in 1972 from 30 August to 2 September at Claremont, California, and afterwards will take part in a Congress of societies for the study of religion there from 2 to 6 September.
