- 2. Scope of the Mathematical Proceedings. Papers which advance knowledge of mathematics, either pure or applied, will be considered by the Editorial Committee. Papers in languages other than English should be sent only after prior consultation with the Editor.
- 3. Correction of proofs. If a paper is accepted, the author will receive in due course page proofs for him to correct and return within one week. To minimize disturbance of type, when words or phrases are added in proof, others of equal length should be removed if possible.

If many corrections are made in the proofs, the Council reserves the right to charge the cost.

4. Authors receive 60 free offprints, without covers, and may obtain more on payment. An order form is sent with the proofs.
