Manuscripts should be typewritten (double-spaced and preferably with a wide margin), and should be as concise as possible: *in no case should an article exceed 10,000 words*. Plates and folders can only be accepted on the understanding that authors will themselves bear the cost of them; for half-tone plates, the charge will usually be 30s. References should be arranged in alphabetical order of author's names, at the end of the article; the date of publication should follow the author's name, and the title of each paper should be given in addition to volume and page references. References in the text should be cited by the author's name, followed by the date in brackets.

Authors will receive twenty-five reprints free; no additional reprints can be supplied.
