MAJOR BARWIS-HOLLIDAY AWARD FOR FAR EASTERN STUDIES (1981)

An annual award has been instituted for the best paper submitted to the Society on an East Asian subject, based on the anthropology, art, ethnology, history, literature or religion of China, Japan, the Soviet Far East, Korea, Taiwan and Hongkong. Award-winning entries will be published in the Society's *Journal*. Within the usual format no rigid limit is imposed on the length of the contributions submitted, but it should be understood that the most suitable length is about 6,000 words.

The manuscripts should be typed in double spacing on sheets of A4 size, leaving a margin of at least 30 mm on the left-hand side, and the sheets should be numbered consecutively at the top right-hand corner. Notes should be numbered consecutively throughout the article, and typed on a separate sheet or sheets at the end. Entries for the award should be submitted by 31 December 1981, and addressed to the Secretary, Royal Asiatic Society, 56 Queen Anne Street, London W1M 9LA, England.

The Barwis-Holliday Prize for 1979 has been awarded to Dr. T. H. Barrett of Cambridge for his paper entitled "On the transmission of the *Shen Tzu* and of the *Yang-sheng yao-chi*", which was published in *JRAS* 1980, 168-76.
