## "Landlady's daughter" competition

The winner of the "Landlady's daughter" competition was Dr Neil Conacher, from Ontario. His suggestion for completing the sentence "A significant fact about our personality is that . . ." was as follows:

"... notwithstanding a degree of understandable confusion about the relation of the perceiving-self or ego to other hypothetical constructs within the overall personality, to which the label 'Other' could also apply, we yet remain, if only intuitively, aware of a fundamental qualitative difference between what might be designated the Other-Inside and the Other-

Outside, by which, even in the absence of mature self-other constructs essential to the generation of an empathic relatedness, an epistemological distinction may be constructed between what one sees as oneself, considered as a whole, and what could be defined as somebody else."

The original that Asher quoted read "... there is a subject-object relationship subsisting between the personality and other existing entities which gives the perceived objects their 'otherness' with regard to the observer."
