

Bibliography of Red Data Books (Part 1, Animal Species)

Technically, the first *Red Data Book (RDB)* was published in 1966 and the term has since become widely used to denote registers of threatened wildlife.

The IUCN recently established its Conservation Monitoring Centre in Cambridge, UK, where international *RDBs* for Mammals, Reptiles and Amphibians, Fishes, Invertebrates and Birds (by ICBP) are compiled. In addition, throughout the world a rapidly increasing number of national, or local *RDBs* are being produced. This bibliography attempts to list *RDBs* and similar works published up until the end of 1982. There are certainly some omissions and it is the intention of ffPS to publish regular updates and additions. Copies of any *RDBs* will be welcome, together with references to such works.

For the purpose of this bibliography a *RDB* is loosely defined as any register of threatened wildlife dealing with a region or higher taxa, or entire world listings; consequently monographs of endangered species are omitted.

Especially thanks are due to the *Red Data Book* compilers in Cambridge: Nigel Collar (Birds), Susan Wells and Mark Collins (Invertebrates), Diana Evans (Fish), Jane Thornback and Martin Jenkins (Mammals), and Brian Groombridge (Amphibians and Reptiles); Richard Fitter, who provided many of the earliest references; and Tim Inskipp for help and advice; thanks also to Susan Lloyd, Viv Burton and Gillian Wills who typed the manuscript. However, all errors either of commission or, as is more likely, of omission are the responsibility of the author.
