ELECTION OF HONORARY OFFICERS ELECTIONS TO FILL VACANCIES ON THE COURT OF ELECTORS AND FOR ELECTED MEMBERS OF COUNCIL

Fellows and Members of the College are reminded of their rights in connection with the forthcoming elections for the offices of Dean, Registrar, Treasurer, Editor, Librarian, and Sub-Deans. The relevant sections of the Bye-Laws and Regulations are printed on page 51 of this issue.

In accordance with Regulation XIV Dr Morris Markowe, having held office as Registrar for five years, is not eligible for re-election. The other Honorary Officers are eligible.

The nominating meeting of Council will be held on 31 March 1978, and the last date for receiving nominations will therefore be 2 May 1978.

Fellows and Members are also reminded that nominations may be submitted for vacancies on the Court of Electors and for Elected Members of Council. The relevant Bye-Law and Regulation will be found on page 51 of this issue.
