ELECTION OF PRESIDENT: Notice to Fellows and Members

Fellows and Members are reminded of their rights under the Bye-laws and Regulations, as follows:

Bye-law XI

The President shall be elected annually from amongst the Fellows.

Regulation XI

(1) As soon as may be practicable after the first day of January in any year the Council shall hold a nomination meeting and shall . . . nominate not less than one candidate and not more than three candidates.

Reflections on Mental Health Review Tribunals;

- (2) Between the first day of January and the date which is four clear weeks after the nomination meeting of the Council, written nominations, accompanied by the nominee's written consent to stand for election, may be lodged with the Registrar, provided that each such nomination is supported in writing by not less than twelve Members of the College who are not members of the Council.
- (3) An election by ballot shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations.

The nominating meeting of Council will be held on 10 January 1979, and the last date for receiving nominations under (2) above will therefore be 8 February 1979.
