The authors here trace the biological origins of malaria in Europe and follow the course of the disease from ancient times until its eradication in the twentieth century. This book is not only a historical account, presenting information not previously available, but also an epidemiological study of the geographical, climatic, entomological, sociological, economic, and political factors that have influenced the disease as a public-health problem. D. J. Bradley, K. Kirkwood, and E. E. Sabben-Clare

This book records the views of some of those who took a leading part in the development of health services in Africa during the latter part of the colonial period. These views are often necessarily subjective, but the book will provide a quarry for historians of Africa in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. It also shows how Western medicine gradually came to grips with the problems of combating such scourges as malaria, yellow fever, yaws, and leprosy and by the late 1940s and 1950s had achieved encouraging success. 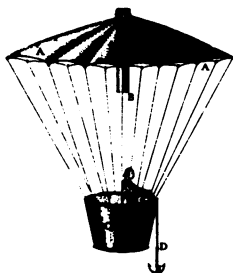

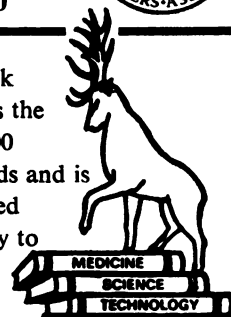
