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In 1964 the journal *Praxis* was founded to serve as a mouthpiece for a group of "creative Marxists" with critical views of Yugoslav policies as well as other issues. The fundamental criticism of the "market" economy as being not in accordance with Marxist assumptions – though temporarily acceptable as a lesser evil – is one of the major issues. A selection has been made of articles which appeared in *Praxis*; it is representative of the philosophical and also of the more immediately political opinions held by writers such as P. Vranicki ("Philosophy in Our Time"), M. Kangrga (on the essence of Marxian philosophy), or R. Supek (on ethical norms for a Socialist society). Some documents reflecting the difficulties which confronted *Praxis* are appended.

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
