Oz Child : Children Australia is an independent, non-government organisation committed to improving the quality of care, life opportunities and status of children throughout Australia by:

- taking or initiating action to protect or enhance the rights of children;
- providing or enabling direct services, through a variety of disciplines, for the benefit of children and their families;
- influencing decisions or actions of individuals, organisations and governments, where relevant to children and their families.

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2. References should be referred to in the text by giving, in brackets, the surname of the author and should be listed in alphabetical order at the end of the article as follows:  
**BOOKS:** Author's name and initials; year of publication in brackets; title of book (*in italics*); publisher; page reference if appropriate.  
**ARTICLES:** Author's name and initials; date of publication in brackets; title of article; abbreviated title of journal (*in italics*); volume and number.
3. Footnotes should be kept to a minimum.
4. Each article should be prefaced with a brief resumé.
5. Contributors are invited to submit a brief biographical note and a current photograph suitable for printing.
6. All manuscripts submitted will be reviewed by three referees. Manuscripts may be accepted for publication, returned for revision or rejected. The Editor's decision is final.
