THE ASSOCIATION FOR SYMBOLIC LOGIC is an international organization for the promotion of research and of critical studies in the field of formal logic. It is intended to provide a meeting ground for mathematicians and philosophers interested in this field, to encourage cooperation and mutual criticism among various groups, and to promote a wider general knowledge and appreciation of current research and recent advances in the field.

THE JOURNAL OF SYMBOLIC LOGIC is the official organ of the Association. It provides a medium for the publication, in English, French, or German, of research and of critical or expository articles in symbolic logic and immediately related fields. Volume 1 contains a bibliography of symbolic logic for the period 1666–1935; a list of additions, and corrections to this bibliography, together with indexes to the whole, appears in Volume 3, Number 4. A complete current bibliography of the literature of symbolic logic from January 1, 1936, including both books and articles, is provided by prompt publication of critical reviews (indexed biennially).

Subscription to the Journal is \$3.00 annually. Single numbers of the current volume are \$1.00 each. Completed volumes (four numbers) will be sold at \$4.00. Single copies of the bibliographical number, Volume 1 Number 4, will be sold at \$1.50 (rag paper edition, \$2.00). Other single numbers are \$1.25.

Offprints of the list of additions, corrections, and indexes to the bibliography are on sale at \$1.00 (rag paper, \$1.25). These contain a title-page and may be bound with Volume 1 Number 4 to form a complete bibliography of symbolic logic to the end of the year 1935.
