THE "INSTITUT FÜR HISTORISCHE ETHNOLOGIE", FRANKFURT AM MAIN

Unlike other anthropological institutions of West German universities, the Institut für Historische Ethnologie at the Johann Wolfgang von Goethe University, Frankfurt am Main, is attached to the history faculty. The research and teaching of members of the institute cover the social and cultural anthropology and the history of non-European peoples, particular emphasis being laid on Africa and on the Indians of North America. The four professors (Eike Haberland, Andreas Kronenberg, Wolfgang Lindig and Klaus E. Müller) take turns as directors of the Institute, which also has two assistants (Ute Ritz and myself). The number of ethnology students in West Germany has grown enormously in recent years, and the Institut für Historische Ethnologie now has over 400 students with anthropology as their main subject, besides a further 200 with it as a minor subject. It is possible to study either for an M.A. or (after that) for a doctorate. The Institut für Historische Ethnologie is located in the same building as the Frobenius-Institut, a research institution primarily devoted to Africa (Director: Eike Haberland). It has also been decided to create a chair for African Languages at the university: this will be located in the same building. Plans are at present being made for a special course in African studies, which will be open to students who already have an M.A. and will combine the human resources which already exist in various departments of the university. The university library (Stadt- und Universitätsbibliothek) contains the largest German collection of publications on Africa (over 100,000 volumes); and the Institut für Historische Ethnologie shares with the Frobenius-Institut and the Frankfurt Ethnology Museum an ethnological library (70,000 volumes).
