Two members of the Journal's Editorial Board have recently been appointed to senior academic and administrative positions.

Dr. T.J. (Jock) Murray has been appointed Dean of the Faculty of Medicine at Dalhousie University effective August 1, 1985. He will succeed Dr. J. Donald Hatcher who has been Dean since 1976. Dr. Murray has been Professor of Medicine and Director of the Multiple Sclerosis Research Unit at Dalhousie. He is past president of the Canadian Neurological Society.

Dr. Charles H. Tator, Professor of Neurosurgery at University of Toronto, was recently appointed Head of the Division of Neurosurgery at the Toronto Western Hospital.
