A list of some of the chapter headings will convey effectively the idea of the book: 'Approach to Penance', 'Penance and Prayer', 'Penance and Humility', 'Going to Confession', 'Concerning Sacrifice', 'Penance and the Eucharist', 'Routine Communions', 'The Mass and Matrimony', 'Sympathy, Love and Matrimony'. There can be no doubt of the need of this book for those living in the world. There have been many good books on these sacraments published in the last decade, but none deals with the spiritual life in precisely this way, a spiritual life which is an essential part of a Christian social life.
