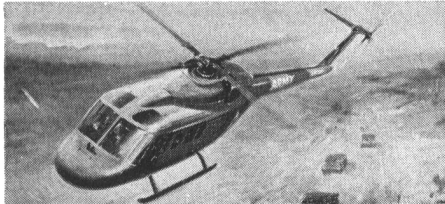
Management Education for Engineers

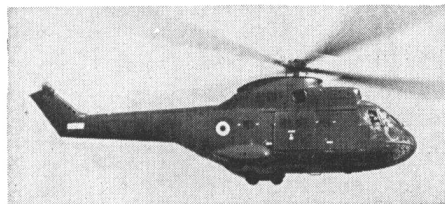

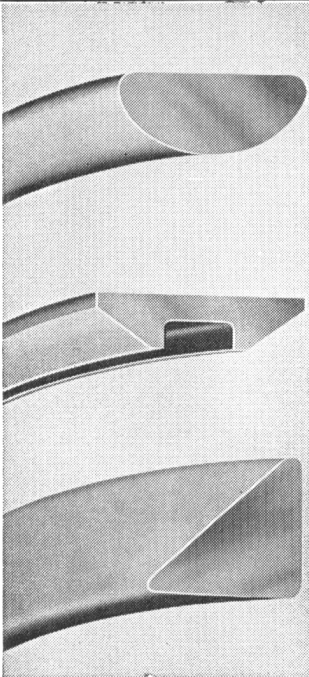
