### INELASTIC BEHAVIOUR IN SHELLS

W. OLSZAK EN A. SAWCZUK

Survey of theoretical and experimental research.

This book surveys the main trends in the theory and research of inelastic shells. After recalling the fundamental field equations for inelastic solids, the main types of viscous and plastic response are analysed. The linear visco-elastic shells are analysed first. In non-linear viscoelasticity special attention is paid to steady creep problems. Further, the theory of elastic-plastic deformation is discussed. Finally, a coverage of the limit analysis theory of shells from the viewpoint of applications in various branches of technology, mostly in structural engineering, is presented. Up to date critical bibliography on inelastic shells is enclosed. The work also includes the results and methods presented at the 'International Association for Shell Structure' symposium on non-classical shell problems, held in Warsaw, 1963, of those presented at the IUTAM Congress, Munich, 1964, and of those presented at the Conference on Elasticity and Plasticity, Zakopane, Poland, 1964.
