Scanning electron microscope image of tin droplets on a textured ZnO:Al substrate. This is used for growing silicon nanowires for photovoltaic applications.

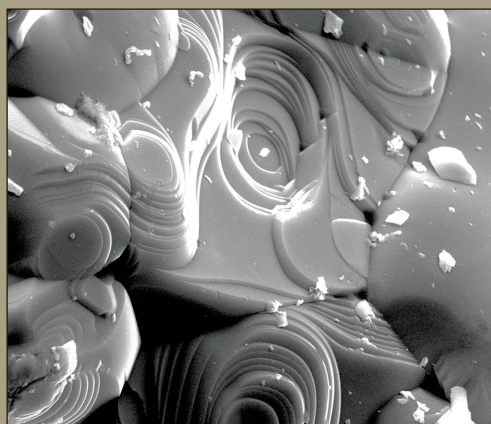
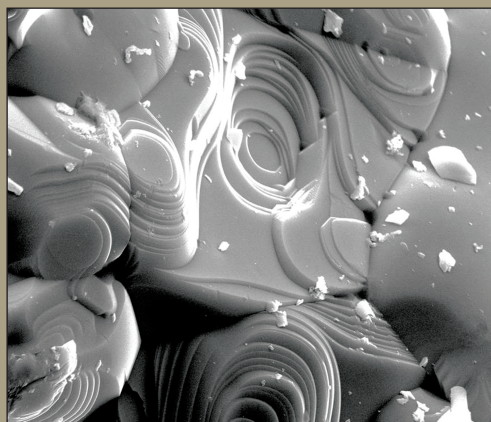

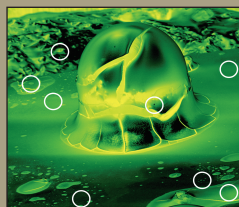
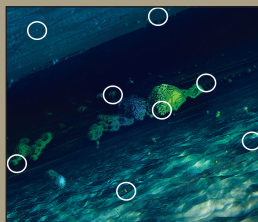
NiSb₂
