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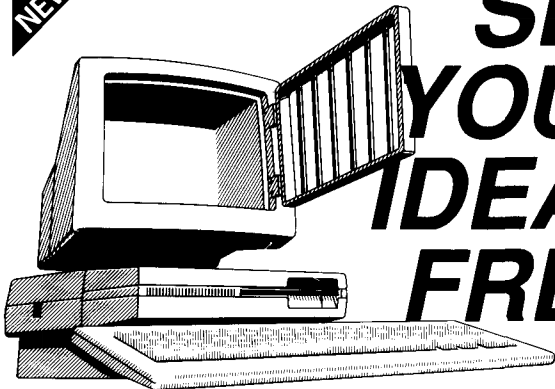
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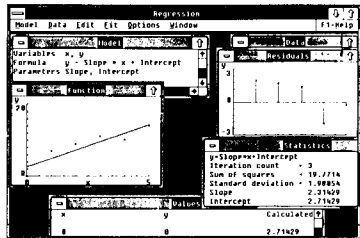
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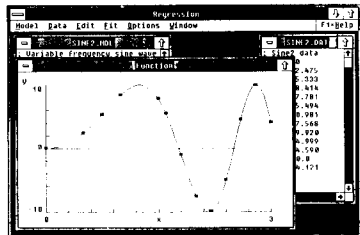

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The first time a species is mentioned its scientific name should be given. English names should be lower case throughout except where they incorporate a proper name.

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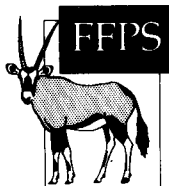
