### ANNUAL TOPICAL INDEX TO RESEARCH INVENTORY: VOLUME I

The Annual Topical Index is to serve as a guide to scholars seeking a ready reference to research projects being conducted on subjects of interest to them. The Index is arranged alphabetically. There has been some cross-referencing, but on the whole, projects have been assigned to only the one topic which most nearly identified it.

As was mentioned in LARR I, 2 the studies enumerated in the research inventory conducted by the CENTRO and distributed as LARR I, 2 Supplement have also been listed in this index along with 11 of the research projects which were reported on in the *Boletín Informativo de Investigaciones Sociológicas* (BIIS) and not mentioned in the Centro report.

Those numbers in regular roman type will refer to LARR numbers and those numbers in italics will refer to CENTRO and BIIS numbers. Because the numbering system used by the LARR for Volume I was progressive, we have not felt the need to refer our readers to a specific issue. However, it might be helpful to note here that Number 1 contained numbers 1-359; Number 2, 360-753; and Number 3, 754-1006.

Whenever possible, the projects have been assigned an historical period. This period is indicated by a letter in parentheses immediately after the number. P—Pre-Columbian; C—Colonial; I—Independence; R—Republican; M—Modern. Those without numbers are, by and large, general studies. Thus most Historical studies are listed under Cultural Dynamics and Archaeological studies under Cultural Dynamics (P).
