ARMY MEDICAL LIBRARY

The Cleveland Branch of the Library has now in press *A Catalogue of In-*

cunabula and Manuscripts in the Army Medical Library. The first part covering incunabula and Occidental manuscripts to 1500 has been compiled by Dorothy M. Schullian. F. E. BROWN UNIVERSITY

Miss Margaret B. Stillwell, curator of the Annmary Brown Memorial of Providence, has been appointed research professor of bibliography at Brown University. The Memorial, which houses art treasures and rare Fifteenth Century books from some of the world's earliest printing presses, has been transferred into the University's keeping.

MEDIAEVAL ACADEMY

At the meeting of the Academy at the Morgan Library on May 1, 1948, discussion was held concerning the Census of Mediaeval and Renaissance Manuscripts in the United States and Canada, prepared by Seymour de Ricci and W. J. Wilson, and published by the H. W. Wilson Company a few years ago.
