

This book is based on the firm view that it is not possible to live as a human being without some idea of what it is to be human. It is not always recognized that there are many such ideas enshrined in the different systems of cultural assumptions that people have about their nature. These are *indigenous psychologies*, and include the cultural views, theories, conjectures, assumptions and metaphors which are concerned with psychological topics. They are also statements about the nature of the person and his relation with the world but, despite their importance, our understanding of them is slight. Nevertheless, each one of us presupposes and depends on indigenous psychologies to maintain our unreflective everyday lives.
