Benefits of SHEA Membership

SHEA dues are applicable for the calendar year. The criteria for membership are available in our new membership brochure, which is available on our WebPage or from SHEA headquarters by telephoning 609-845-1636. SHEA has two official journals: *Infection Control and Hospital Epidemiology* and *Clinical Performance and Quality Healthcare*.

The annual cost of these two journals bought separately is \$194. The \$125 membership dues for 1997, in addition to the journals, pay for the cost of the current resource-membership directory and the (usually) quarterly SHEA Newsletter, each of which facilitates networking with colleagues and enables discounted registration at the annual meetings and other

educational programs offered by SHEA or by SHEA in collaboration with organizations such as the CDC, IDSA, and IHCI. The dues also support the work of the SHEA committees, as well as the continued production of SHEA position papers, an index of which is highlighted in the current SHEA Newsletter.
