The Division of Neurology, Department of Medicine, University Health Network/Sinai Health System (UHN/SHS) at the University of Toronto is seeking full-time, permanent Clinician Investigator Neurologists with a focus on Epilepsy Neurology. The candidate must be eligible for a full-time clinical academic appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor or higher at the University of Toronto. The effective start date is negotiable.

The successful candidate will hold an MD degree and have, or be eligible for, certification in Neurology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO). He or she will have specific additional training such as a Master's degree or equivalent. Furthermore, the candidate must have completed an Epilepsy Fellowship and have established expertise in clinical care in Epilepsy.

The successful candidate will be part the clinical epilepsy service for inpatient and ambulatory care at KBI. The candidate will be expected to participate in epilepsy specialty clinics and EEG reporting. In addition, there will be participation in on-call for general neurology. The candidate will be responsible for developing and integrating their research interests into the current Epilepsy program with a focus on epilepsy of autoimmune disorders and/or genetic epilepsies.

Teaching duties will include fellows, post graduate residents and undergraduate medial students as per Division of Neurology requirements.

The successful candidate will participate in all clinical and academic aspects of the UHN/SHS Neuroscience Program. Academic appointment will be within the Division of Neurology, Department of Medicine, University of Toronto and income will be commensurate with training and experience.
