Now, for the first time, an extended study of philosophy in English Canada traces its history from 1850 to 1950, examines the major English-Canadian philosophers in detail, and sets them in the context of the main currents of Canadian thought.

Leslie Armour, who holds the Ph.D. from the University of London, is Professor of Philosophy at the University of Ottawa. His major works are Logic and Reality and The Concept of Truth.

Elizabeth Trott, who holds the Ph.D. from the University of Waterloo, has taught philosophy at several Canadian universities. She has written and presented national radio programmes on philosophy and education for the CBC.
