

Take some other words

The examples illustrate only some of the senses of each word.

Play

- a stage drama: She's written a new play.
- engage in fun: The children are playing in the garden.
- take part in a game: The team are playing away next week.
- gamble: We were playing for very low stakes.
- perform with a musical instrument: I can play the trumpet.

Charge

- electrical power: The battery needs charging.
- price: They charged us too much for the bread.
- task: Your charge is to look after the children.
- accusation: They were all charged with burglary.
- military attack: The charge of the Light Brigade.

Train

- part of a dress: The bride's train was held by two little children.
- group of followers: A long train of mourners followed the coffin.
- course of action: I couldn't follow the train of his argument.
- railway vehicle: We caught the early morning train.
- teach: I was trained as a carpenter.
