Several have alternative spellings, e.g. *yuck* can appear as *ick*, *ich*, *yeugh*, *yick*, *yich*, and more. The list could be greatly extended if we included all the content words that can be used as isolated emotional noises, such as *awesome*, *baloney*, *bingo*, *mama mia*, and *rubbish*, or taboo expressions such as *damn*, *darn*, and *shit*.
